Dues/Health & Dues Structure per month

Health & Welfare

Health & Welfare per month = 261.34

Included in the 261.34 is the Death Benefit of \$30,000.00

This is:

Single - \$17.60

Family - \$19.44

Single over the age of 65 - \$9.44

Family over the age of 65 - \$11.34

Death Benefit will increase to 60,000.00 with an increase of about \$2.00 per month

Death Benefit will increase to 30,000.00 for members who are over the age of 65

The total Health & Welfare will then be about \$263.34 per month.

Dues Increase

This is a breakdown of the Dues payment per month.

Total dues per month (\$53.00 regular dues + \$93.00 working/Travel) = \$146.00

From the 146.00 we deduct \$4.14 which covers the 6,000.00 death Benefit in the Hall.

There is no age limit on this if you pay dues you are covered for \$6,000.00.

Then we deduct \$32.00 which is the International (Washington) Portion.

The total left, \$109.86, stays in the IBEW Local 1852 Union hall.

Out of Work Dues/Regular Dues

Total Dues per month is \$53.00

From the \$53.00 we deduct \$4.14 for you \$6,000.00 in House Death Benefit

And we deduct the International Portion, \$32.00, which goes to Washington.

The total left, \$16.86, stays in the IBEW Local 1852 Union Hall.
